for the Advanced Metering Infrastructure ("AMI") Project

On December 19, 2007, FortisBC filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") for its proposed AMI Project (the "Project"). Pursuant to the Regulatory Timetable established by Commission Order No. G-1-08, the Commission and Registered Intervenors submitted Information Requests ("IRs") No. 1 and No. 2, and FortisBC responded on February 26, 2008 and March 19, 2008, respectively.

FortisBC, as a result of subsequent discussions with the Provincial Government and other stakeholders, is of the opinion that additional benefits, which provide further support for the 2007 BC Energy Plan, should be provided. This will be achieved by augmenting the functionality of the preferred solution beyond that initially proposed, specifically by means of a provision for hourly readings through a Validation, Estimation and Editing ("VEE") equipped Meter Data Management Repository; and support for in-home consumption display capabilities.

On March 19, 2008, FortisBC advised the Commission that it intends to file an amendment to the Application on or before March 31, 2008. Concurrently, FortisBC will provide updated responses, where appropriate, to IRs No. 1 and No. 2, reflecting the amended Application. Accordingly, FortisBC requests a postponement of the Regulatory Timetable, and will propose a revised schedule in its amended Application.

The Commission acknowledges the importance of this AMI Application and thereby grants a postponement of the existing Regulatory Timetable to FortisBC. Furthermore, the Commission requires that FortisBC introduce an additional round of IRs for the Commission and Intervenors in the proposed revised schedule that will be incorporated in the amended Application.
