**Re: FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI)**

**Application for Approval of Code of Conduct (COC) and Transfer Pricing Policy (TPP) for Affiliated Regulated Businesses Operating in a Non-Natural Monopoly Environment (ARBNM) (the Application)**  
**Request for Regulatory Timetable Amendment**

On June 27, 2014, FEI filed the Application as referenced above. On September 18, 2014, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (the Commission) issued Order G-143-14 setting out the Regulatory Timetable for the review of the Application, setting October 8, 2014 as the date for Commission and Intervener information requests (IRs) to FEI.

FEI is respectfully requesting an extension to the timetable. In addition to the number of IRs received in this Application being higher than anticipated, there is considerable overlap of resources involved in this Application and in the preparation of the 2014 and 2015 rates compliance filings resulting from the Multi-Year Performance Based Ratemaking decision and the implementation of Common Rates. An amendment to the Regulatory Timetable is necessary in order to ensure FEI is able to focus resources on preparing and submitting the rates compliance filings as early as possible, allowing adequate time for Commission review and issuance of decisions to ensure timely implementation of rates.

FEI is proposing the following amended Regulatory Timetable.

FEI Reply Submission	Wednesday, November 26
